Bringing crores of Tribal and rural brethren into the main stream of National Progress

STUDIED BY: ONGC, A CSR SUPPORTER

ONGC, a CSR supporter, undertook an independent study for project performance and societal impact of Ekal Vidyalaya. The main findings of the study are:

- Ekal Vidyalaya is facilitating the children of socially and economically deprived society in terms of providing basic education with inputs of values and culture and preparing them to integrate with formal schooling.
- Sensitivity and feeling towards healthy habits, hygiene, surrounding cleanliness, and physical fitness has improved.
- Respect for human dignity, rights, gender equity, national integration, honesty, cooperation and concern for life among the students have been enhanced.
- Substantial improvement has taken place on interpersonal communication skills of students.
- Succeeded in enhancing the skills among students to recognize and identify the source of electricity, mode of transport, medical instruments, conduct simple investigation to seek answer to queries, able to apply learning of scientific concepts in day-to-day life.



Spread of literacy and values – 73 lakh students passed, Ekal students linked to formal schooling

Solution of national problems - Cooperation in removing religious conversion, Naxalism, Maoism, terrorism, migration from cities, illiteracy, diseases, poverty etc. - About 17900 schools in border 21000 schools in villages, Naxal affected areas, 70% tribal population benefited from Ekal. 80% Acharyas and servants are from tribal and deprived communities.

Ekal Student of Assam Pinki Karmakar Run for India With London Olympic Torch, in Nottingham Square on 28th June 2012






Women Empowerment - 50% of the children studying in Ekal school are girls, the number of women teachers is 72%, the number of full-time women workers is 22%, women with IT education are working in GRC centers whose number is 40%, 30% Women are trainers in Ekal On Wheel, 20% women are trainers in Organic Nutrition Garden. Boys and girls are receiving education in almost equal proportions.

For overall development of villages - Reported School - 90787, Student-25.93 lakh, Arogya Resource Centre-63, Benefitted villages - 1635, Beneficiaries - 28.32 lakh, Sanskar Shiksha - Weekly classes, Rath Yojana -72, Cow Van, Gramothan Resource Centre- 14, out of which 187 projects are going on. 11.06 lakh villagers are being benefited by these projects, Ekal On Wheel- 46, Skill Development Centre-8, Integrated Village Development-39, Seva Vrati Karyakarta- 7418, No. of People Connected -1.74 Cr.




